

Title of course: **Intermediate level Creative Photography and Photoshop:**

This course is aimed at students who have completed the Beginners Class in Creative photography or are comfortable with the basic functions of a digital SLR camera and who want to tell their own story through images.

1. Mastering ANY camera. Making the switch to Manual; Refresher class on camera basics; Aperture, Depth of Field, Shutter Speed, ISO.
2. Reading imagery. Exploring project creation, themes and the photo-essay. Preparing for your own project: Finding the right subject for you.
3. Class demo: Flash/Studio lighting. Using light and shadow for portraits. Understanding light, shape and form.
4. Composition: Making the rules work for your image making.
5. Peer review of project work. Techniques for critiquing images
6. Adobe Photoshop v's Adobe Light room; Non-destructive image editing and archiving. Using online galleries.
7. Adobe Photoshop: Perfecting your image.

9. Reviewing your project. Presenting and sharing your work.
