Beginners (A11):

The beginners' course puts immediate emphasis on communication skills. Practice in the language of real life situations, practical and functional – ask your way, find things out, order food and drinks and so on, all in a relaxed and friendly atmosphere.

If your native language is Roman / Latin (French, Portuguese, Italian) in origin we advise you to enrol in the Continuation Class.

Continuation (A1.2):

This course is for those who have already attended beginners' class, or who have 10 weeks experience of learning the language. The course will provide you with the means to express yourself in a particular context and to ensure that you learn not just phrases or expressions but also patterns of language that you use and continue in other contexts and situations. To learn the language will also give you access to the culture and history.

Intermediate: (A2):

This course is aimed at students who have a good basic grasp of the present tense and a reasonable vocabulary. Ideally students should have completed at least 30 hours of tuition in Spanish. Emphasis in oral communication and grammar.
